

## **Robert E. Lee Camp Soldiers' Home Applications for Admission**

**BIGGS, Robert T. Company H, 23rd Battalion Virginia Infantry. Enlisted at Patrick County on July 27, 1863. Applied to admission to Lee Home of February 22, 1899 at age 55. Application signed by D. K. Smith and T. G. Tatum. Discharged at his request August 15, 1907.**

**HEFFLEFINGER, Henry A. Company K, 50th Virginia Infantry. POW, Snickers Gap July 18, 1864. POW, Washington D. C. and Elmira, New York. R. E. Lee Camp Soldier's Home, September 2, 1919. Died, February 9, 1922. Buried Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond.**

**HUBBARD, Thomas M. Company D, 51st Virginia Infantry. Enlisted in Giles County, but resided in Woolwine, Patrick County, Virginia. POW, Waynesboro, March 2, 1865. Released from Fort Delaware Prison, June 20, 1865 Applied for admission to Lee Home on May 9, 1895 and approved on July 11, 1895.**

**PENN, Abram C. Company G, 10th Virginia Cavalry. Conscripted from Stella, Patrick County, Virginia, July 27, 1864. WIA, Amelia Court House in April 1865. Applied for admission to Lee Home on February 12, 1914. Discharged at his request September 17, 1914. Reapplied on May 5, 1916, but was rejected.**

**SCOTT, James G. Company I, 5th Battalion Virginia Reserves. Conscripted at Patrick Court House in June 1864. Born in Patrick County on April 27, 1847. Applied for admission to Lee Home on April 6, 1927. Application signed by J. C. Justice. Discharge at his request on June 14, 1928. Died and buried in Tazewell County, Virginia, on February 8, 1932.**

**SHELOR, Samuel F. Company C, 51st Virginia Infantry. Applied to Lee Home on August 24, 1909 and entered on November 27, 1912. Application signed by W. T. Akers and Isaac N. Akers. Died on furlough in Roanoke on June 22, 1913.**

**STOVALL, George W. F. (1845-1902). Company H, 58th Virginia Infantry. Enlisted at Patrick Court House on September 5, 1861. WIA, Fredericksburg, December 13, 1862. Applied for admission to Lee Home on February 15, 1902 due to indigence, age 54.**

**TERRY, Robert A. Company C, 10th Virginia Heavy Artillery. Enlisted at Jamestown in March 1862. Applied to Lee Home on July 25, 1889, due to Kidney disease, age 69.**
